

Challenge 40 Show of Cars

Welcome Porsche Friends! It is our pleasure to welcome you to the 40th Chesapeake Challenge Concours and Car Show. A special welcome all Boxsters and their owners from PCA's Boxster Registry, who will be joining us for this very special event. This year, we are celebrating our first ever in-town Challenge, and with that comes special requirements for parking, timing, and your cooperation and patience in making this all come together.

When entering the CC40 Show of Cars you have the choice of entering Concours or the Car Show. Below is a description of both categories to assist your decision. Please plan on arriving at the Concours/Car Show location at Everedy Square and Shab Row in Frederick (near the corner of East Street and Church Street) between 8:00AM - 9:00 AM. Once you have arrived, someone from the CC40 staff will direct you to your ASSIGNED parking location either at the designated Concours or Car Show Paddock areas. Please follow the directions of our staff to minimize congestion and your time on the streets. We want to get you safely and quickly parked so that you can begin final preparations for the Concours judging or Car Show voting. Parking "paddocks" will be open at 8:00 am. Please do NOT park on the streets, even if you do not wish to be judged in the car show or concours. We will have designated parking off street for all participants. Final preparations are permitted for Concours judging until 10:00am after which only light dusting is permitted.

The Concours

As in previous Challenges, the Concours will be a Street or Top-Only event with judging limited to the exterior, interior, engine compartment, storage area and wheels. The underside of your car will not be judged. Judging will commence at 10:00 a.m. The judging team will have a maximum of five minutes to judge your car. The judges will require that your car be opened during judging, please stay near your car! Tops on open cars need to be erected. You are allowed to perform light dusting on your Porsche from 10:00am up to the time your car is judged. Please have your score sheets filled out and available to the judges to prevent undue delays. Please be ready.

Age Points

To help level the playing field we are awarding age points only. For every year older a Porsche is than the newest in its class, it will receive a half point (0.5). For example, if you have a 1974 911 and someone has entered a 1977 911, you receive 1.5 points. No mileage points are awarded, they have proven to be too complex and subject to dispute in the past. Best of Show will be determined on raw score alone (no bonus points).

The Car Show

Once again this year, your vote counts in the Car Show! The Car Show winners will be determined by balloting from fellow Challenge participants. Challenge participants will vote for their favorite car in specific Car Show Classes (below), this year highlighting Boxsters. Each entrant will receive a ballot in their Challenge registration packet. Please be sure to check out all entrants in the Car Show field and vote! All ballots must be submitted by 1:00 PM.

People's Choice

All Porsches entered in the Car Show and the Concours are eligible for the People's Choice Award. On your ballot please vote for your favorite Porsche in the Paddock areas. All ballots must be submitted by 1:00 PM.

Honorary Judge's Choice

Representatives from Everedy Square and Shab Row will be honorary judges for Chesapeake Challenge 40. They will be selecting their favorite Porsche to receive the Honorary Judge's Award.
